Sodium Dialysate Trial



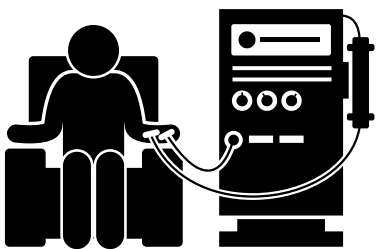
1 WHAT IS SODIUM?

Sodium is a mineral found in most of the food we eat. The most common source of dietary sodium comes from table salt. Sodium is an element of your dialysate fluid. It helps cleanse the blood during your dialysis session.



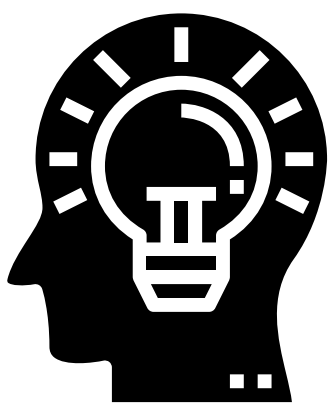
2 WHAT IS THE RESOLVE TRIAL?

This approved trial will run in the background during your dialysis sessions for approximately 4 years. The trial aims to find out which dialysate sodium concentration is best for patient health.



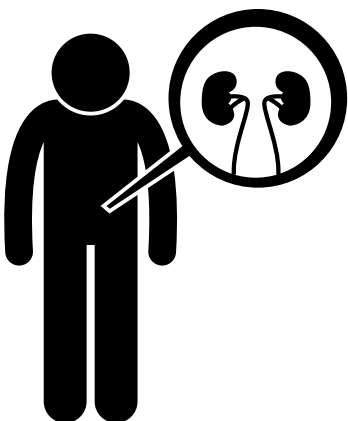
3 WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO?

You do not need to do anything other than attend your routinely scheduled dialysis sessions.



4 WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW?

All patients receiving care in this unit are a part of this trial. This trial has been approved by an ethics review board, the dialysis unit, and your nephrologist. The dialysate sodium concentrations used for this trial are standard of care within this unit.



5 HOW WILL THIS AFFECT YOU?

This trial will run in the background and have no impact on your current healthcare.
